

Rev 7:10; Ze 6:13



The great plan of redemption was laid before the foundation of the world. And Christ, our Substitute and Surety, did not stand alone in the wondrous undertaking of the ransom of man. In the plan to save a lost world, the counsel was between them both; the covenant of peace was between the **Father and the Son**. "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only-begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life." The Majesty of heaven, the King of glory, would become a servant. The only-begotten Son, in whom the Father delighted, was given for the ransom of a fallen race. {ST, December 23, 1897 par. 2}




Note: the holy spirit is spoken of as being shed abroad, poured out; it is represented as water, rain, air, wind breath, life, tongues of fire, a dove, etc..


How many Divine Beings were present at Jesus Baptism?

Never before had angels listened to such a prayer as Christ offered at his baptism, and they were solicitous to be the bearers of the message from the Father to his Son. But, no; direct from the Father issues the light of his glory. The heavens were opened, and **beams of glory** rested upon the Son of God, and **assumed the form of a dove**, in appearance like burnished gold. The dove-like form was emblematical of the meekness and gentleness of Christ. While the people stood spell-bound with amazement, their eyes fastened upon Christ, from the opening heavens came these words: "This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased." 2 SP 60, 61

What does the Bible call that light from God that assumed the form of a dove?



And straightway coming up out of the water, he saw the heavens opened, and the **Spirit** like a dove descending upon him: Mk 1:10

And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the **Spirit of God** descending like a dove, and lighting upon him: Matt 3:16

And the **Holy Ghost** descended in a bodily shape like a dove upon him, and a voice came from heaven, which said, Thou art my beloved Son; in thee I am well pleased. Lk 3:22

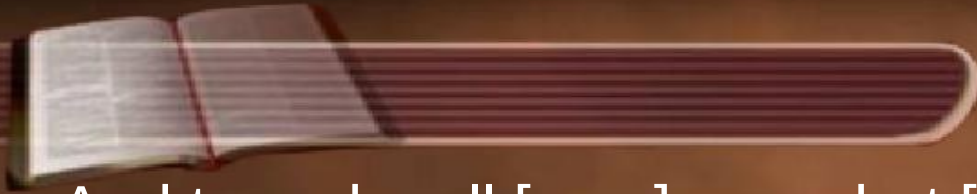
How many divine beings created all things?



I saw in the night visions, and, behold, [one] like the **Son of man** came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the **Ancient of days**, and they brought him near before him.

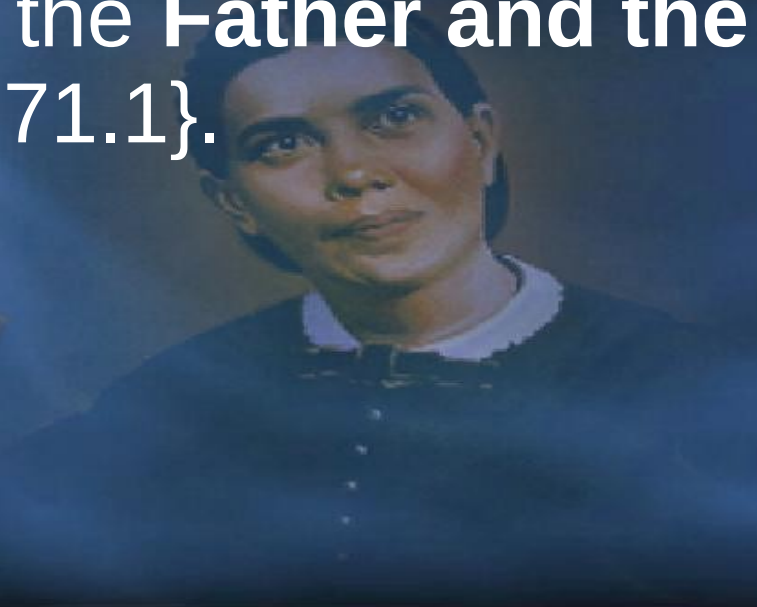

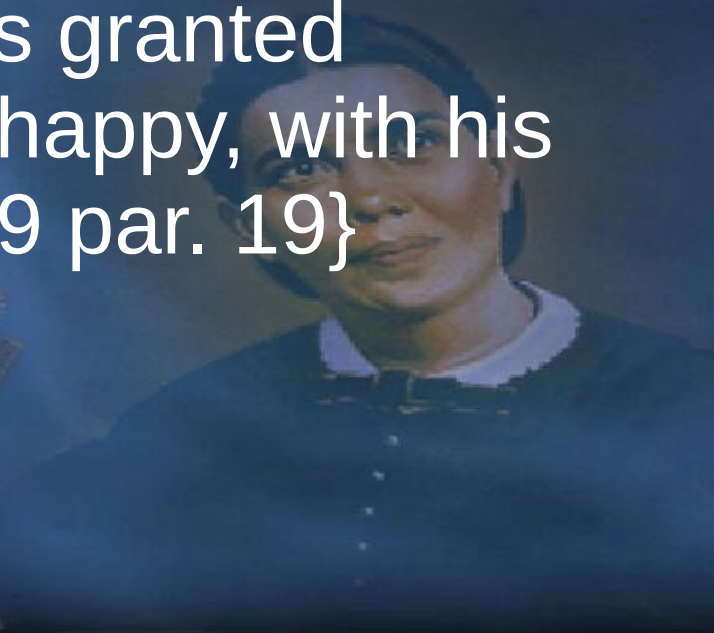
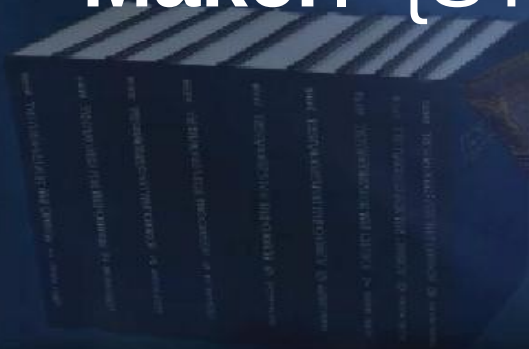

To Adam in his innocence was granted communion, direct, free, and happy, with his **Maker**. {ST, January 30, 1879 par. 19}

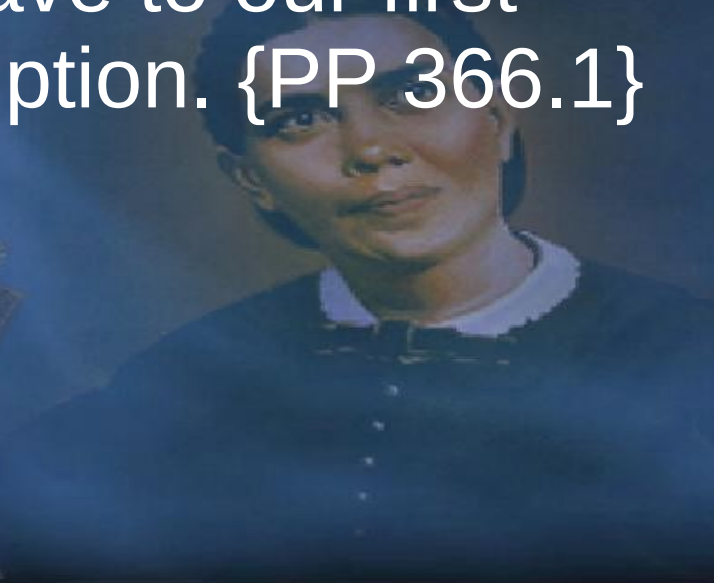

It was the **Son of God** that gave to our first parents the promise of redemption. {PP 366.1}



How Many divine beings can man communicate with?

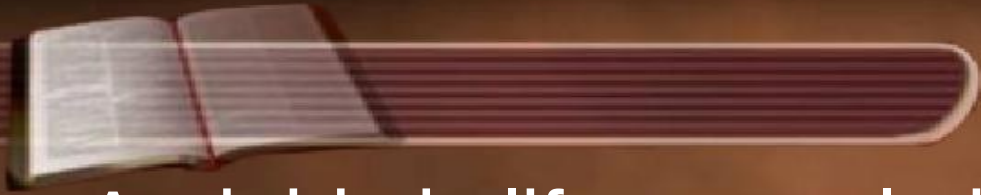



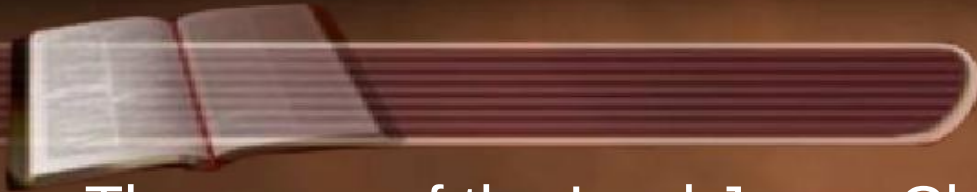

The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Ghost, be with you all. Amen. II Co 13:14



Opposite them will be a record of sins, of mistakes, failures, neglects, and such ignorance in spiritual knowledge that the Father and His Son, Jesus our Advocate, and ministering angels will be ashamed to own you as children of God. {3T 224.1}

But that the world may know that I love the Father; and as the Father gave me commandment, even so I do. Arise, let us go hence.

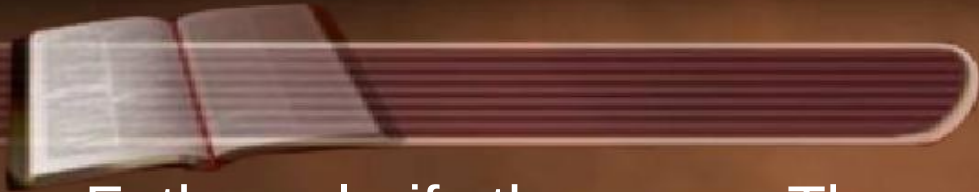
How many divine beings love each other?

“***Satan*** in Heaven, before his rebellion, was a high and exalted angel, ***next in honor*** to God's dear Son.” 1 SP 17.1

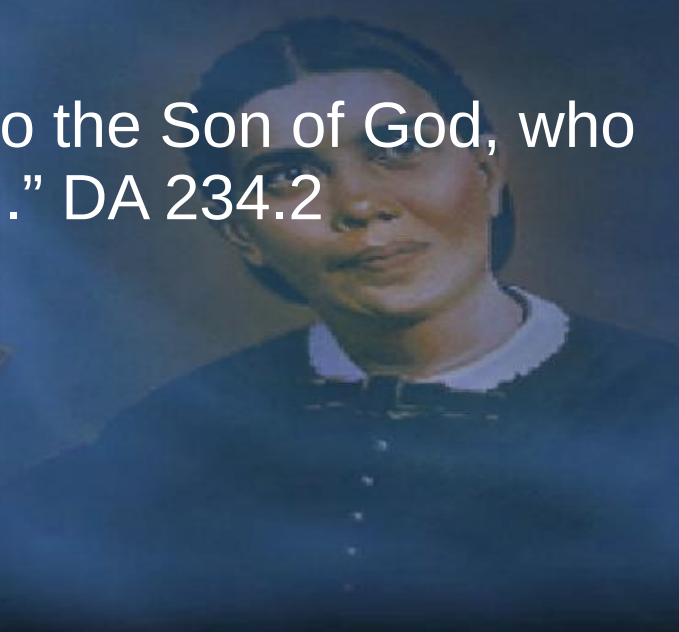


