Repentance

2 Corinthians 7:11

“For behold this selfsame thing, that ye sorrowed after a godly sort, what carefulness it wrought in you.”

carefulness = σπουδή (*spoudé*), from which comes our English word *speed*. However, this word also signified *care, attention to details, or diligence*.

2 Timothy 2:15

“**Study** [Grk. *spoudé*] to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.”

2 Peter 1:5

“And beside this, giving all **diligence** [Grk. *spoudé*], add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge.”

Romans 12:11

“Not slothful in business; fervent in spirit; serving the Lord.”

The phrase “not slothful in business” (τῇ σπουδῇ μὴ ὀκνηροί), may be translated, “diligently, not slothfully” etc.



Attention to detail

Repentance:

μετανοέω (*metanoéo*³³⁴⁰) v: to change your understanding; to repent

μετάνοια (*metánoia*³³⁴¹) n: a change of understanding; repentance

“And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the **renewing of your mind** [repentance], that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.”

Jeremiah 13:23
